Product description

pH-neutral water based stripper for the removal of old care layers. Especially developed for finished hardwood and cork floors, also suitable for PVC and linoleum floors. Removes old care layers and heavy soiling.

Suitable for all water-resistant floors such as finished parquet and cork, PVC, polyolefin, rubber and linoleum. Never use on asphalt.

Preparation

Remove loose dirt and dust in advance with a vacuum cleaner, brush or mop.

Information on Use

Stripping: Mix CareRemover in a ratio of 1:4 with water and apply with a spray can or mop. After a short exposure time buff the surface with a single disc machine fitted with a LOBATool Special pad green. Vacuum off dissolved dirt and care residues by using a wet/dry vacuum cleaner, a mop or cloths. On larger areas work in sections. In order to reduce wood swellings only use as much water as required. Limit exposure time of the cleaning solution to a minimum. If necessary repeat procedure.

In order to remove all residues of the cleaning solution, damp mop the entire area with a mop and clear water. After thorough drying, performing an initial care with for example with LOBA® ParkettCare is necessary.

Intensive cleaning: Heavy soiling and black heel marks, that cannot be removed with LOBA® Cleaner, can in many cases be removed by using CareRemover in a ratio of 1:10 with water for cleaning. Damp mop the floor with this solution and a suitable mop. Immediately after cleaning damp mop the floor again with clear water in order to neutralize cleaning residues. Heavy stains and soilings can be selectively worked with a cloth, brush or a LOBA Special Pad green put under a single disc machine. (The use of abrasive pads or other abrasive cleaning tools might lead to scratches on the surface).

We suggest testing the suitability against certain soilings at one spot before cleaning the entire area. Dirt that has already penetrated into the finish or that has undermined the finish cannot be removed entirely.
