### Preparation:

Remove bulky dirt and dust (vacuum-cleaner, broom). Moisten large areas (terraces) if necessary.

### Information on Use:

Apply Deck & Teak Refresh undiluted deeply with a brush and allow to take effect for approx. 10 minutes. Work over alongside the woods' graining with a scrubber or a brush and make sure to consistently clean the scrubber with clean water. Afterwards rinse the entire surface afterwards with clear water. Repeat procedure in case of heavy soilings or prolong exposure time of Deck&Teak Refresh.

Oil-impregnate surface with Deck & Teak Oil after complete curing.

### Caution:

Protect adjacent sensitive surfaces from splatter with a protective foil. Avoid contact with metals during the application. Use synthetic brushes and scrubbers if possible. Never use a high-pressure cleaner or coarse sanding paper the surface might be roughened too much or damaged. In order to remove stains and heavy soilings use fine sanding paper grid size P120-P250 and manually sand surface. Remove sanding dust with a wet cloth.
